Interstate & Highway Directions To The Columbia Marriott Hotel

From Charleston & I-95 and I-26 West

Follow I-26 west and continue past Columbia exits until Exit 111-B (Highway 1/Augusta Road, West Columbia). Bear to the left at the third light and follow signs for Jarvis Klapman Blvd/Highway 12. After crossing the bridge into the city, Jarvis Klapman becomes Hampton Street. Go through five traffic lights. After the 5th light, the Columbia Marriott Hotel will be on the right after the corner of Main & Hampton Streets.

From Atlanta, Augusta, Aiken & I-20 East

Follow I-20 until you reach the I-26 East Interchange. Take I-26 East toward Columbia and Charleston. Continue on I-26 East staying in center left lane and merge with I-126 East. From I-126 take the Huger Street Exit and continue ½ mile. Turn left on Hampton Street. Continue ½ mile – about 5 lights – on Hampton to Main Street. The Columbia Marriott Hotel will be on the right after the corner of Main and Hampton Streets.

From Greenville & Spartanburg & I-26 East

Follow I-26 East to Columbia. Continue on I-26 East staying in center left lane after Exit 106 to avoid taking I-26 to Charleston. Merge with I-126 East two miles after exit 106 and follow to downtown Columbia. From I-126 take the Huger Street Exit and continue ½ mile. Turn left on Hampton Street. The Columbia Marriott Hotel will be on the right corner of Main and Hampton Streets.

From Myrtle Beach & Florence & Hwy 501 & I-20 West

From Myrtle Beach follow Highway 501 to Highway 76 (junction outside of Marion). Follow Highway 176 to Florence, then follow signs for I-20 West. From Florence continue on I-20 to I-277 South (Exit 73). I-277 becomes Bull Street in downtown Columbia. Continue on Bull Street to right turn on Hampton Street. Follow Hampton three blocks and The Columbia Marriott Hotel will be on the left at the corner of Main and Hampton Streets.

From Myrtle Beach/Conway/Sumter via Hwy 378

Follow Hwy 378 to Columbia. Hwy 378 becomes Garner's Ferry Road. Continue on Garner's Ferry as it becomes Devine Street. Stay in right lane on Devine Street to access right fork at Millwood Avenue (Dreher High School will be on the right). Continue on Millwood to left on Gervais Street. Continue on Gervais Street about one mile to right on Sumter Street. After three blocks on Sumter, turn left on Hampton. The Columbia Marriott Hotel will be on the left at the corner of Main and Hampton Streets.

From Greenwood & points West via Hwy 378

Continue on Hwy 378 to Columbia as you approach the Congaree River. Hwy 378 becomes Gervais Street as it crosses the river. Cross the Gervais Street Bridge and turn left on Assembly Street. Continue three blocks and turn right on Hampton Street. The Columbia Marriott Hotel is on the right after the corner of Main and Hampton Streets.

From Charlotte & I-77 South

Follow I-77 South to I-277. Follow I-277 to downtown Columbia. I-277 will turn into Bull Street in downtown Columbia. Continue about three miles to Hampton Street. Turn right on Hampton and go four blocks past Sumter Street. The Columbia Marriott Hotel is at the corner of Main and Hampton Streets on the left.
